Audi Sport customer racing teams score multiple podiums at Mid-Ohio

- Audi R8 LMS GT4 and RS 3 LMS gain valuable championship points
- Carbahn Motorsport and Road Shagger Racing find the podium twice in the two race weekend
- Two different TCR teams receive top honors finishing first in class
- IMSA Michelin Pilot hosts rounds 6 and 7 at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course

Columbia, SC, September 29, 2020 – Audi Sport customer racing had much to celebrate during the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course weekend double header. The Audi R8 LMS GT4 and the Audi RS 3 LMS TCR found the success in both races giving Audi much needed points with three races remaining in the 2020 season.

Carbahn Motorsports with Peregrine Racing's Audi R8 LMS GT4 scored a double podium during the Mid-Ohio race weekend with driver pairing Jeff Westphal and Tyler McQuarrie behind the wheel. With multiple IMSA Michelin Pilot Championships on the line, the team pressed on to finish 2nd in race 1, narrowly missing the top spot by 1.3 seconds. A hard fought second race placed the team in 3rd after a 20 minute shoot-out at the end of race 2. Steve Dinan, Team Principal, and his two car team had much to celebrate with the #93 Audi R8 LMS GT4 driven by Mark Siegel and Tom Dyer finishing in the top five. Carbahn Motorsports with Peregrine Racing is now second place in the GS class Driver and Team Championships with Audi also in second place in the GS Manufactures point standings.

Audi RS 3 LMS TCR teams had a phenomenal race weekend at Mid-Ohio. Fast MD Racing with Speed Syndicate captured pole position in race 1 and went on to win the race. Drivers James Vance and Max Faulkner pushed the Audi RS 3 LMS to a commanding lead during the 75 lap 2 hour race. Road Shagger Racing, with teammates John Morley and Gavin Ernstone, finished race 1 in 3rd. Race 2 would prove to be even better for the Las Vegas based Road Shagger Racing team. After another two hours of racing, the team took the checkered flag in the TCR class scoring critical points toward the TCR championships. The Road Shagger Racing team now sits fourth overall in the TCR Drivers and Team Championships with Audi in second place in the TCR Manufacturers point's standings. Rounding out the Audi RS 3 LMS TCR weekend success was JDC-Miller MotorSports placing 3rd with Michael Johnson and Stephen Simpson.
