Audi Sport customer racing teams ready for Watkins Glen International

Watkins Glen International will host two consecutive IMSA races at the historic NY race track. Sahlen's Six Hours of The Glen will go green on Sunday, June 27, and five days later the WeatherTech 240 that replaces the Canadian CTMP event. Two Audi R8 LMS GT3 race car will highlight the six hour event for

Carbahn with Peregrine Racing has entered the Six Hours at the Glen to continue their development and test the endurance capability of the highly capable Audi R8 LMS GT3. New to the GTD format, Carbahn, led by Steve Dinan has already completed two races this season as they continue to dial-in the race car and push for their first IMSA GTD podium. Piloting the car this weekend will be Richard Heistand (B), Jeff Westphal (S), and Tyler McQuarrie (S). The team will return to its normal line-up for the WeatherTech 240 with Heistand and Westphal.

The second Audi R8 LMS GT3 will be entered by NTE Sport. The Texas based team returns to IMSA competition after making a run at the Rolex 24 At Daytona. Drivers Don Yount (B), Jaden Conwright (S) Markus Palttala (G) will share driving duties during the Six Hours of the Glen.

IMSA Michelin Pilot Challenge – GS and TCR
Three Audi R8 LMS GT4s will continue to push for valuable manufacturers points in the very competitive GS field. The McCann Racing driver pairing of Davis (S) and McCann Jr. continue to improve finishing positions throughout the 2021 season. FastMD Racing also elected to maintain two drivers in the 4 hour endurance IMPC endurance format with Alex Papadopulos and James Vance. Carbahn with Peregrine Racing rounds out the GS class for Audi. Returning to the team is sixteen year old Nolan Siegel who last raced at the IMPC Daytona event. Nolan will be paired with his father, Mark Siegel and Tom Dyer.

The #61 Road Shagger Racing Team with Jon Morely and Gavin Ernstone are full throttle this year.

Currently sitting third in the team championships, the driver pairing have proven they are ready to capture the title. Earlier in the year, the team finished first overall at Sebring in the Audi RS 3 LMS SEQ. Unitronic-JDC Miller MotorSports team has demonstrated that the RS 3 LMS SEQ is a formidable competitor in the TCR category. Finishing first overall at Daytona, driver Taylor and Miller, joined by Will Tally this weekend, have plenty of races remaining to climb back to the top of the championship.

Practice and qualifying for the Tioga Downs Casino Resort 240 take place Friday on the iconic 3.4-mile, 11-turn Watkins Glen road course. The race streams live at 2:30 p.m. ET Saturday on TrackPass on NBC Sports Gold.
